Vogt was able to travel and visit other areas of our great country and realized, "there's no place like home". Berwick was where he returned to start his life and began his life long business by delivering and selling furniture at the age of 25. Vogt assisted the former Miller's Furniture with their retirement sale, emptied the existing inventory and started Homestead Furniture from scratch. Vogt's experiences in the military carried over into his business philosophy. "Systems provide outcomes, if you're not getting the outcomes you want, check your systems". Vogt has been using this ideology in running his business and it has served him well. Homestead Furniture has been listed in Furniture Today, multiple times, as Beyond the Top 100 in the retail furniture industry. Vogt knows, no matter what happens, "I know my goal everyday is to open the doors and sell furniture, not get bogged down by the ancillary".

Vogt continues to look at growth and development for his company. Having eight employees, four of which have been with Homestead for thirty years he sees his employees as extended family and wants to provide them with growth opportunities. Homestead has a highend website that is comparable to the national chains and is set to launch their online purchasing. Within a 30 mile radius of the Berwick/Nescopeck area people can purchase online and receive free delivery. Vogt sees the value in adapting to changing markets, his email tagline reads: "If you don't like change, you're going to hate extinction", author unknown.


